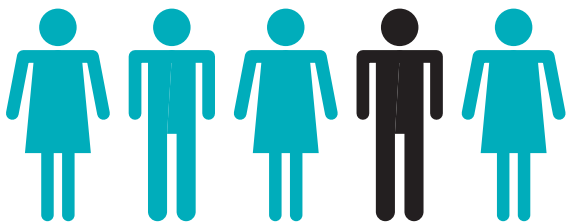
Did you know?

Improved access can increase visitation opportunities of people with disability by four times

Changing Places toilets are larger than regular accessible toilets. They enable the people with a disability, who require a hoist and/or height adjustable change table, to access the community.

MLAK Locking System

Most Changing Places toilets are locked with an MLAK (Master Locksmith Association Key) system. These can be purchased from the Master Locksmith Association or borrowed from Mornington Peninsula Shire customer service centres in Rosebud, Mornington and Hastings.
